## **Training Video Repair Instructions**

If you have experienced problems viewing the training videos you may need to install an Audio Codec to resolve this issue. Anthology has placed the codec on our site for your convenience. The file name is "AudioCodec.exe" and is located on the *Customer Zone*  $\rightarrow$  *Download Page*  $\rightarrow$  *Other Downloads* section. The image below shows what the link looks like

Download AudioCodec.exe

- Click the download link
  - FireFox and Chrome users
    - The default download directory is called "Download"
  - o IE users
    - You will have the option to choose where to download this file. You will need to know the location for step two
- Next, locate the AudioCodec.exe file you just downloaded and double-click to start the installation.
- In just a few seconds the installation completes and you are ready to go.
