

As of May 30th, 2022, Google will require all third-party apps (including Anthology) to create an app specific password for security purposes.

1. In your browser, sign into your Gmail account that Anthology sends from. You should see your small circle logo near top right corner- click on to get the option for "Manage your Google account."

Copy the 16-digit code from this page and paste it into Notepad®. When you do, you'll see something like this: wlgqqgzlixnfgmgo if you paste this into the password field in Anthology – it will not work. You need to break it apart like this: aera wlgq qgzl ixnf gmgo. Now you can cut this value from Notepad and paste into the password field.

- 9. From the Anthology main menu.
  - Open Tools | Options -> Email
  - Locate the SMTP Password field and paste/write in the new password. "remember the step above" the password needs to broke apart.
  - F10 Save. Close and restart Anthology
